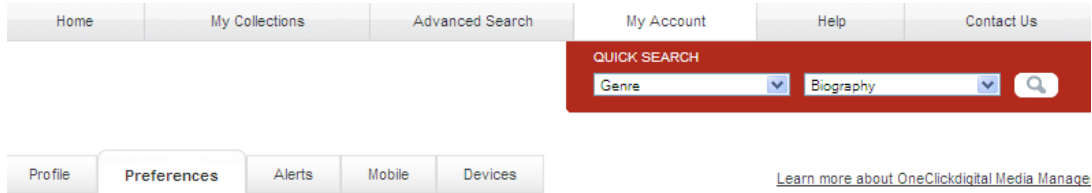


Downloading and Transferring Titles on Your Mac

Setting Account Preferences

1. Confirm that you are logged into your OneClickdigital account.
2. Click the *My Account* tab, followed by *Preferences*. Confirm that your preferences are set as follows, clicking *Update Preferences* after making any changes:

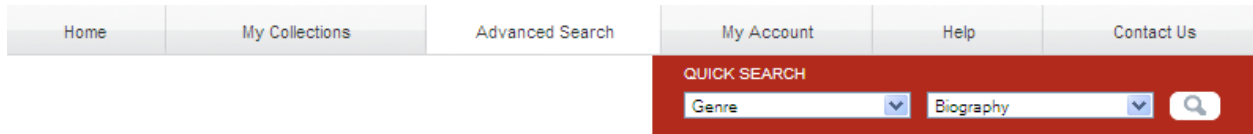

Searching for Titles

3. Click the *Advanced Search* tab.
4. Enter your search criteria (title, author, narrator, etc.) in the appropriate fields.
5. Select *Yes* to *Show only available titles*.
6. Click *Search*.

9. Click *Download*.

- b. Which is a: Binary File
- c. Cancel or Save File

10. Select *Save File*.

11. Double-click on the .zip file.

- a. Archive Utility runs and creates a Download folder.

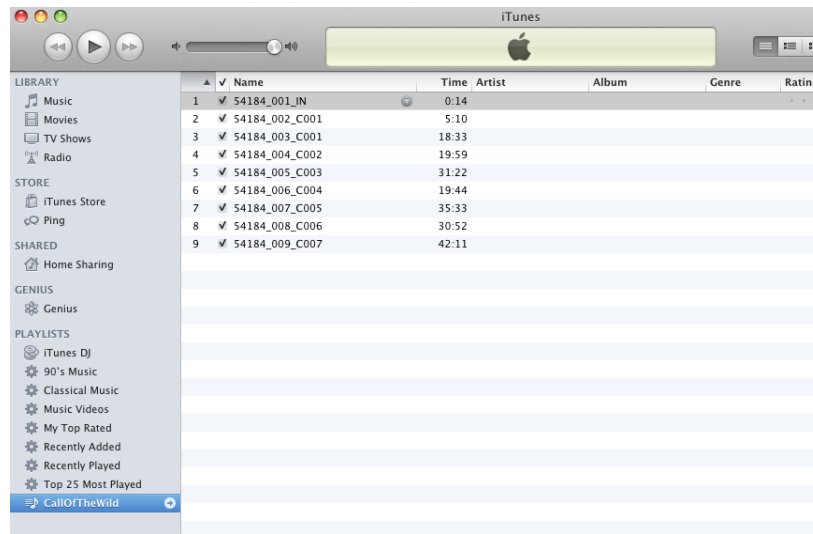
12. Click and drag the folder with the title to the desktop.

13. Minimize your browser.

14. Open the folder and double-click on the M3U file sharing the name of the title.

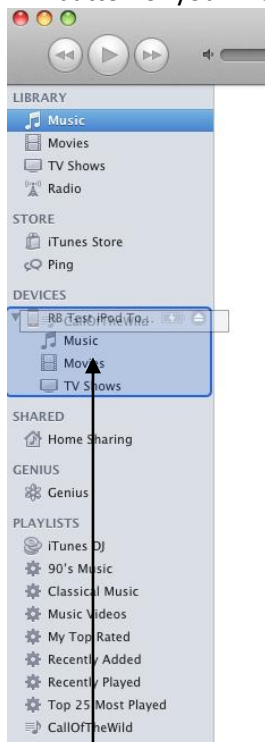

Transferring to Your Device

16. Verify that your Apple device is connected. Click on the playlist and, while holding down the left button of your mouse, drag and drop the folder onto your device.



17. Allow the sync with your device to complete.
18. Disconnect your device. The title is now ready to be enjoyed.
