

Transferring Titles to Your MP3 Device

1. Log into the OneClickdigital website. Click the My Account Tab, followed by Preferences. Confirm that your preferences are set to the following:

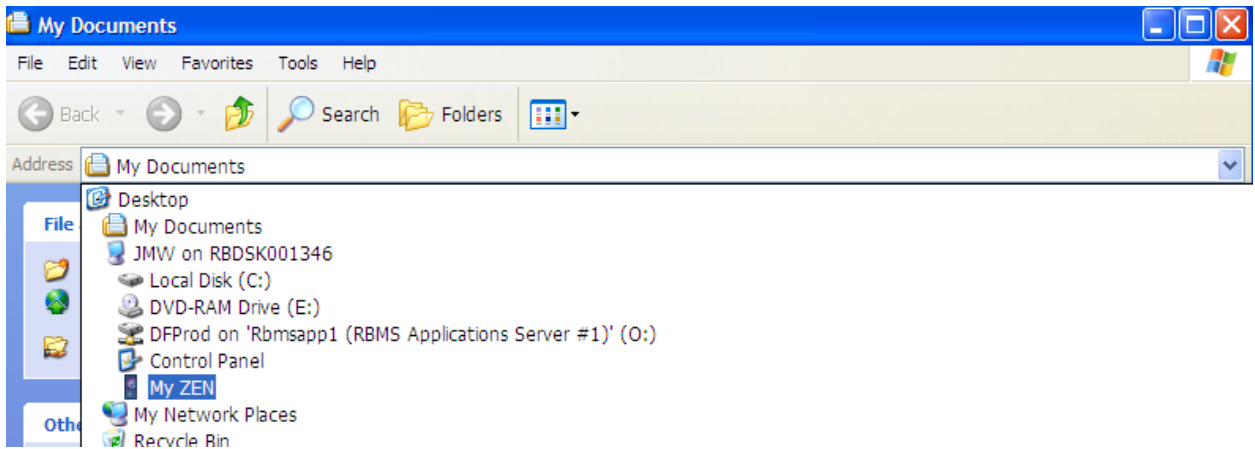

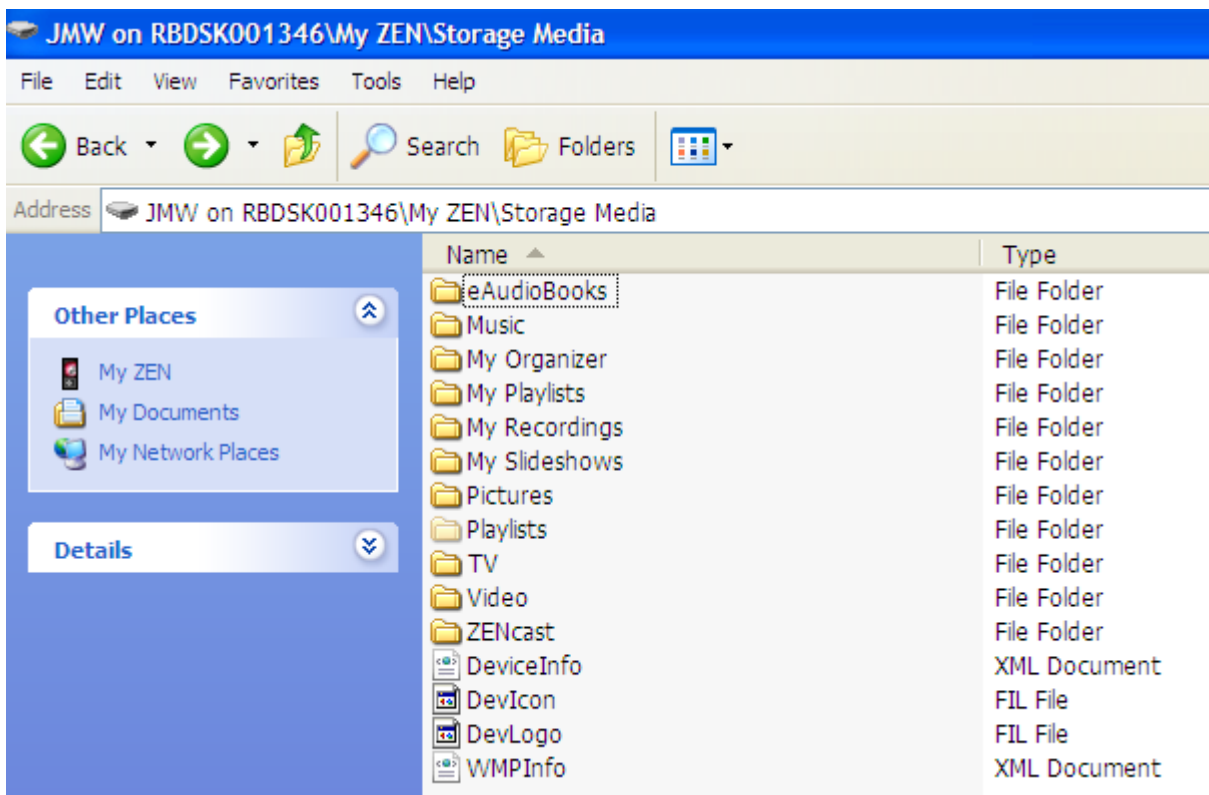

2. Check out the desired title on the OneClickdigital website and download via the OneClickdigital Media Manager.
3. Confirm that your device is connected to your PC.
4. Open your device folder. To access the folder, select your device from the drop-down menu in Windows Explorer.



5. Keep this window open. It will be needed for future steps.

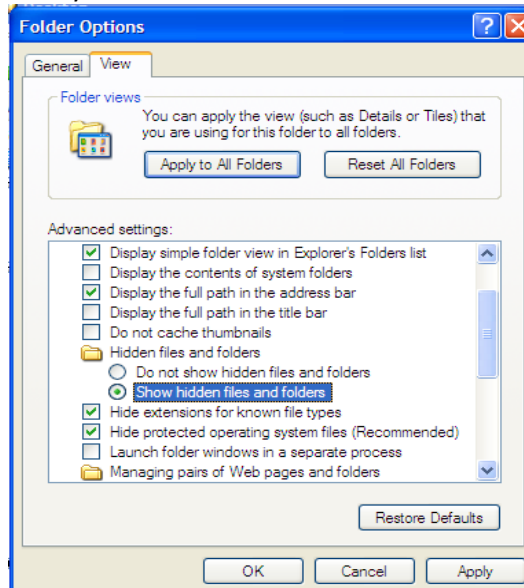


Windows XP Users

6a. Right-click on Start Menu and then click Explore.

6b. Select Folder Options under the Tools menu (Upper Left)

6c. Click View and confirm that you show hidden files.

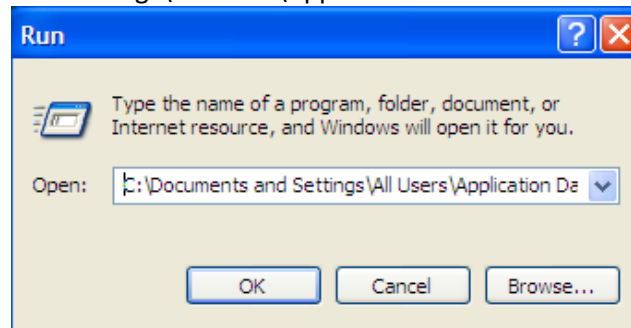


6d. Click Apply and then OK if you had to change that option. If not, just click Cancel.

6e. Close window

6f. Click Start button and then Run

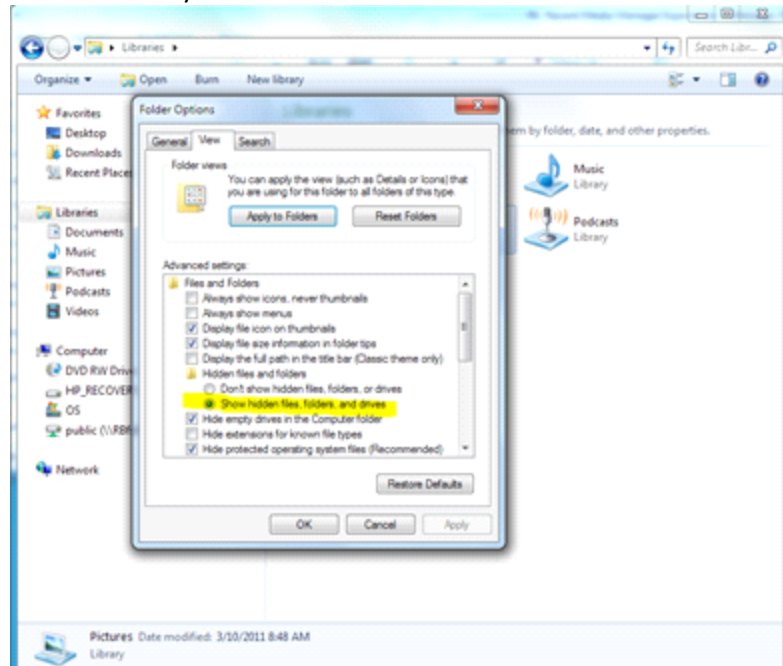
6g. Type C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Application Data Click OK.



6h. Double-click OCD Files, and Proceed to Step 7.

Windows 7/Vista Users

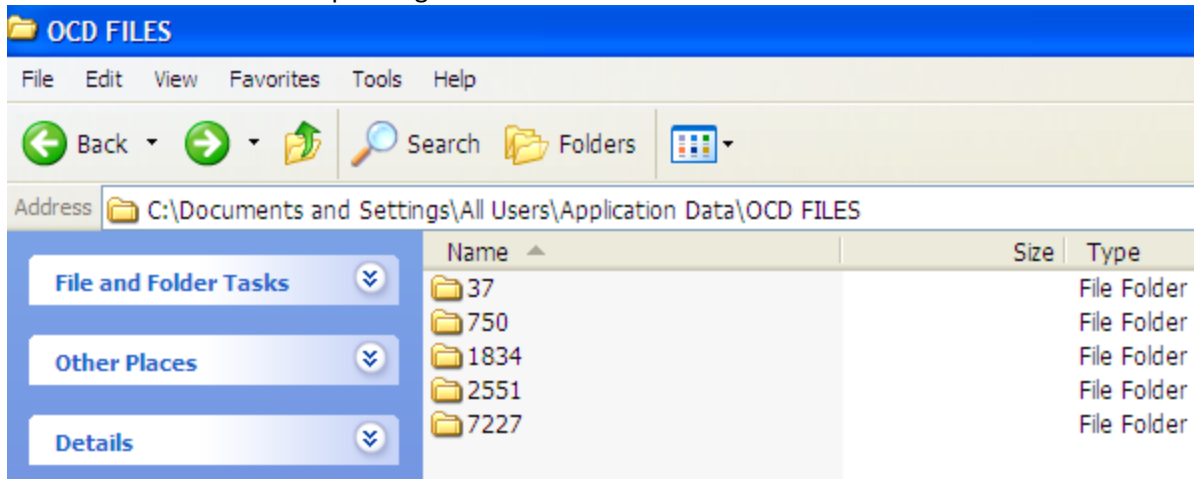
- 6a. Right-click Start Menu and Open Windows Explorer. Select Folder and Search options from the Organize dropdown (Upper Left)
- 6b. Click View and confirm that you show hidden files.



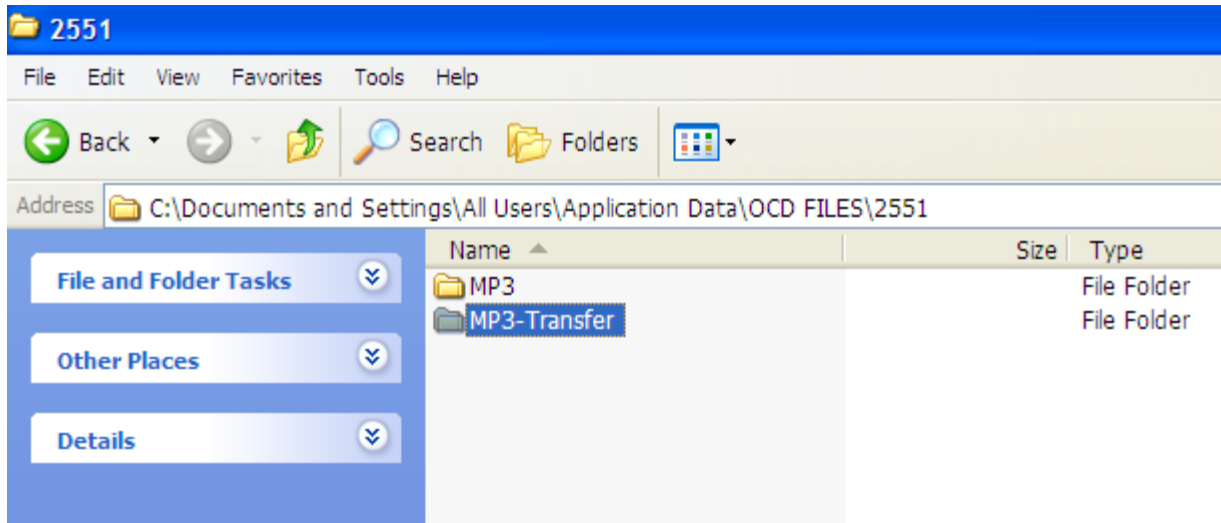
- 6c. Open Start menu. In the address bar enter `c:\programdata` and hit enter.

- 6d. Double-click *OCD Files*.

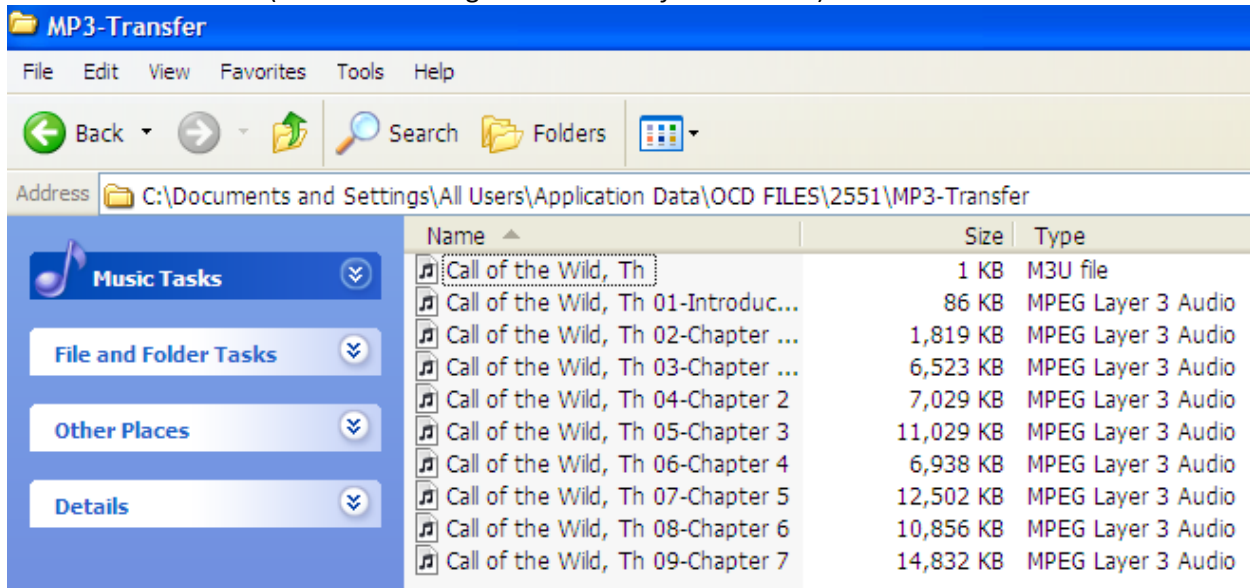
7. A separate folder will be created for each title you have downloaded, named with a unique number to a corresponding title. Double-click one of these folders.



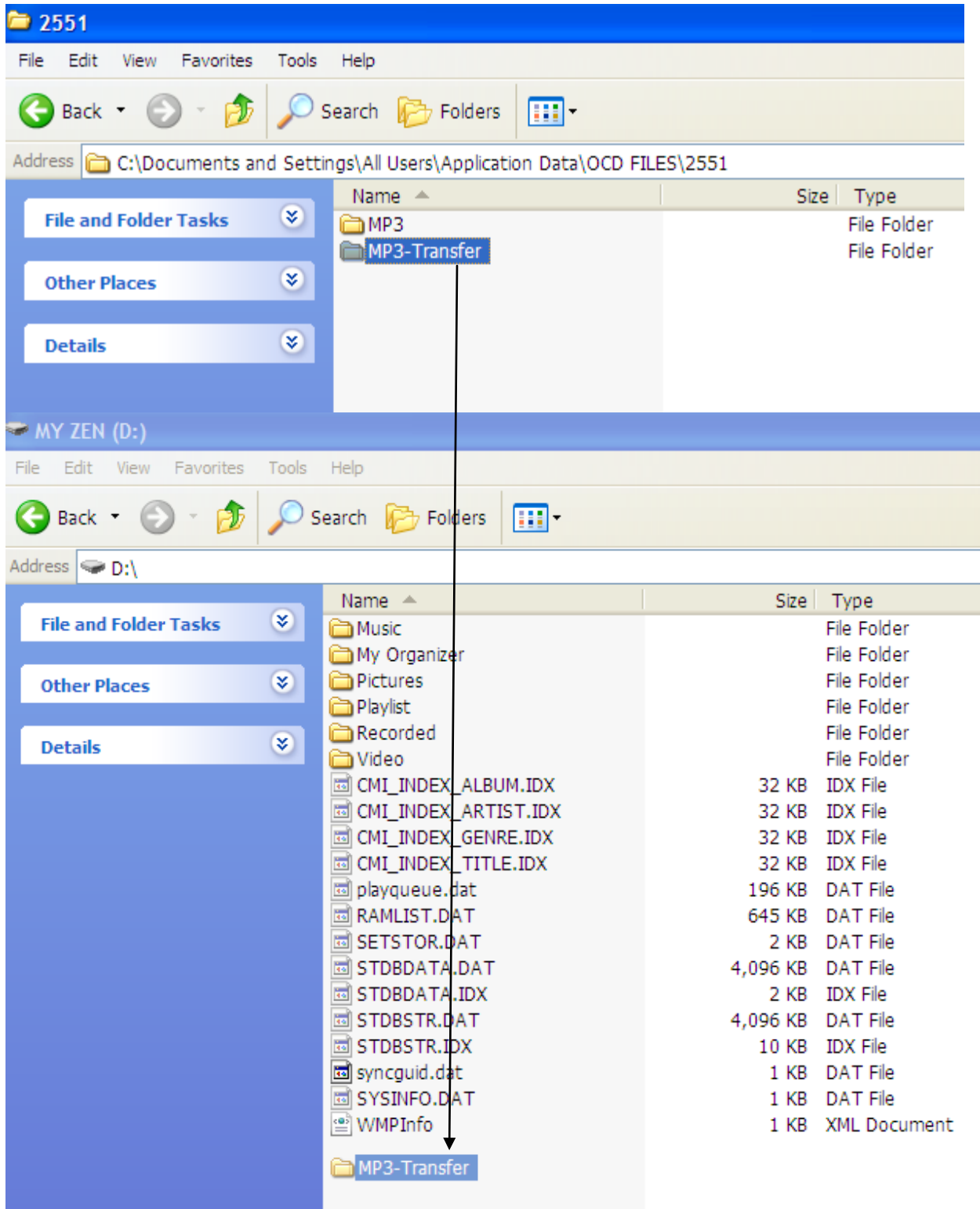
8. Double-click the *MP3-Transfer* folder.



- The title and additional track information will be displayed in the track names. Return to the above screen (folder containing the *MP3-Transfer* subfolder).



- Left-click the *MP3-Transfer* folder and hold the mouse button down while you drag this into your device folder. (Warning: do not add it to an existing subfolder.)



11. Allow all files to transfer. After the transfer is complete, you can find your title on your device in the Music folder. Disconnect device and enjoy!
