

Transferring Titles to Your WMA Device

Setting Account Preferences

- Log into the OneClickdigital website. Click the My Account Tab, followed by Preferences. Confirm that your preferences are set to the following:

- Click *Search*.

Saving Your Search

- When the search results load, go to the right-hand side of the screen under the *Refine Your Search* options. You will see the options *Save: Query Delete Saved Queries*. Select *Query*.
- Name your query and click *Save*.
- After you save at least one search, you will have a new tab on the Home tab of your library's OneClickdigital website which displays your search results called My Search. If you have more than one saved query, you can go to *My Account / Preferences* tab under *Select your Home Page search* to select which search you want to appear on that tab.

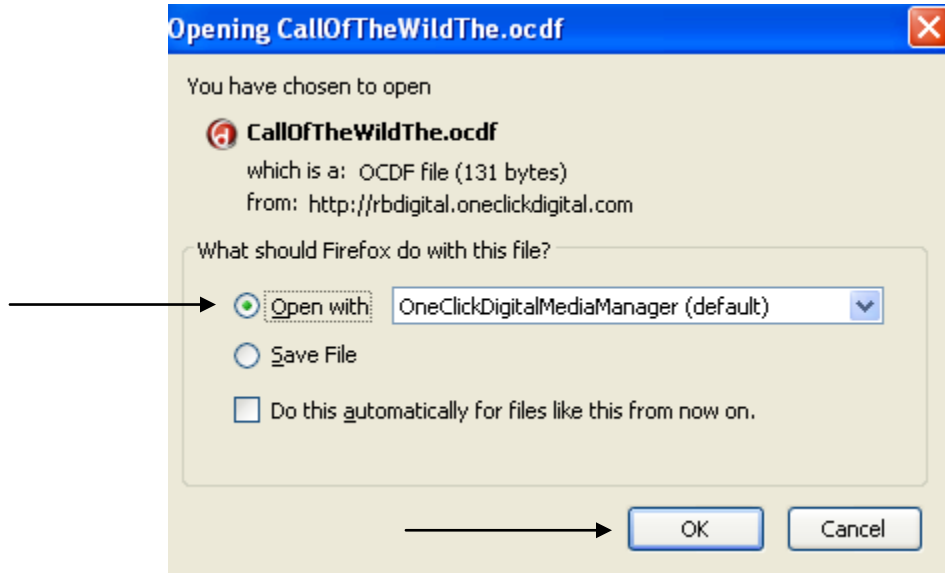

- Check out the desired title on the OneClickdigital website.

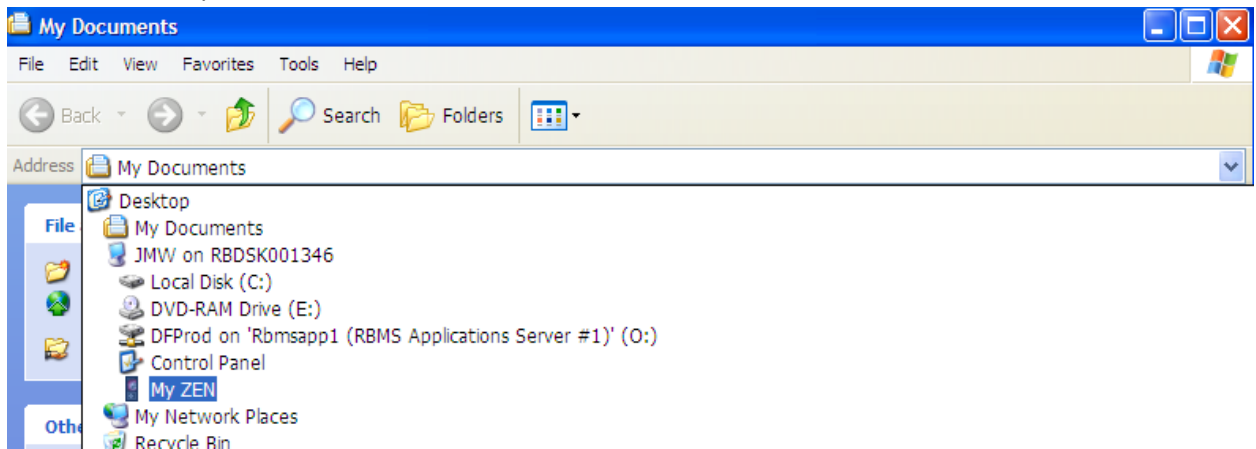
- When prompted to download the .OCDF file, click *Open* or *Run*, depending upon your browser. This will prompt the OneClickdigital Media Manager to open. This can also be opened by accessing the *Recorded Books* folder from your desktop's *Start Menu*.



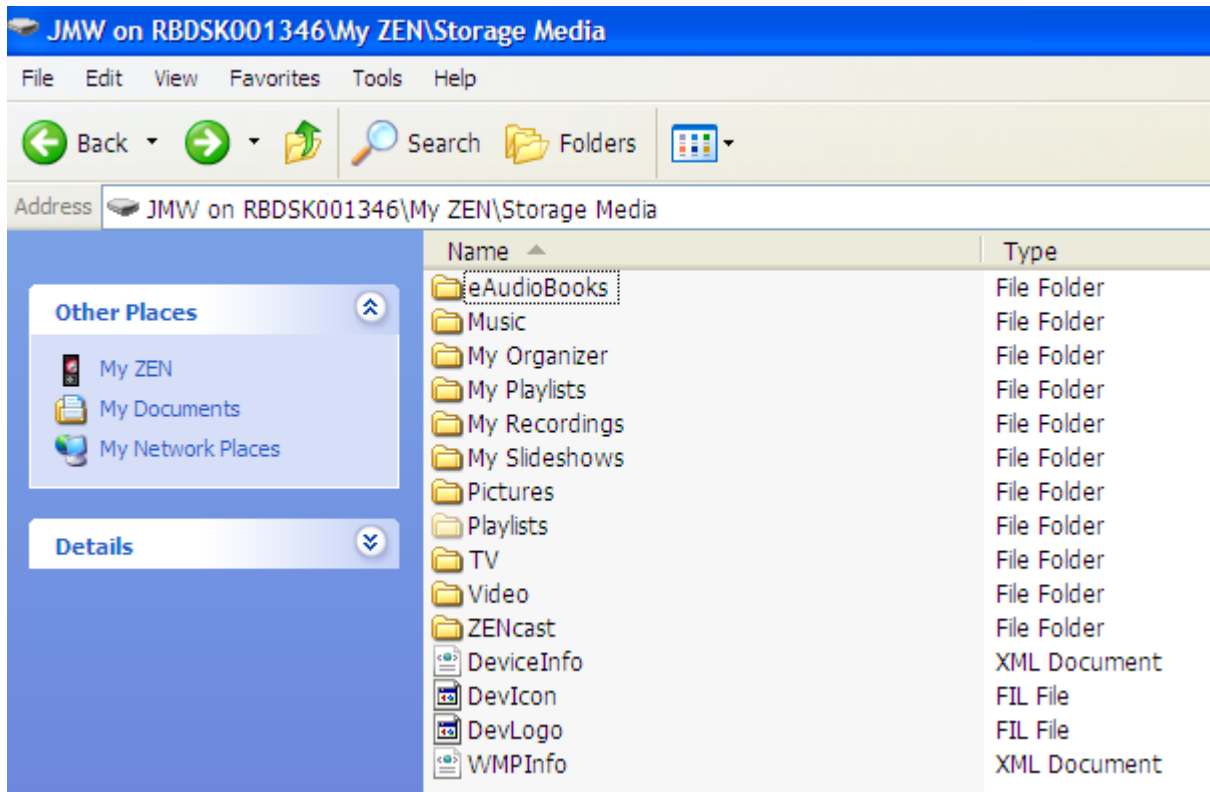
- Allow the title to download via the OneClickdigital Media Manager.

Locating Your Device Folder

- Confirm that your device is connected to your PC.
- Open your device folder. To access the folder, select your device from the drop-down menu in Windows Explorer.



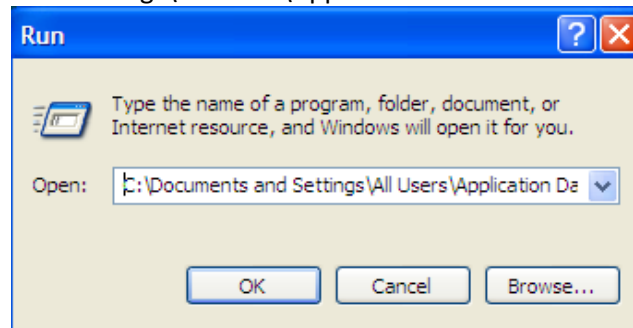
- Keep this window open. It will be needed for future steps.



Locating the Title's Audio

Windows XP Users

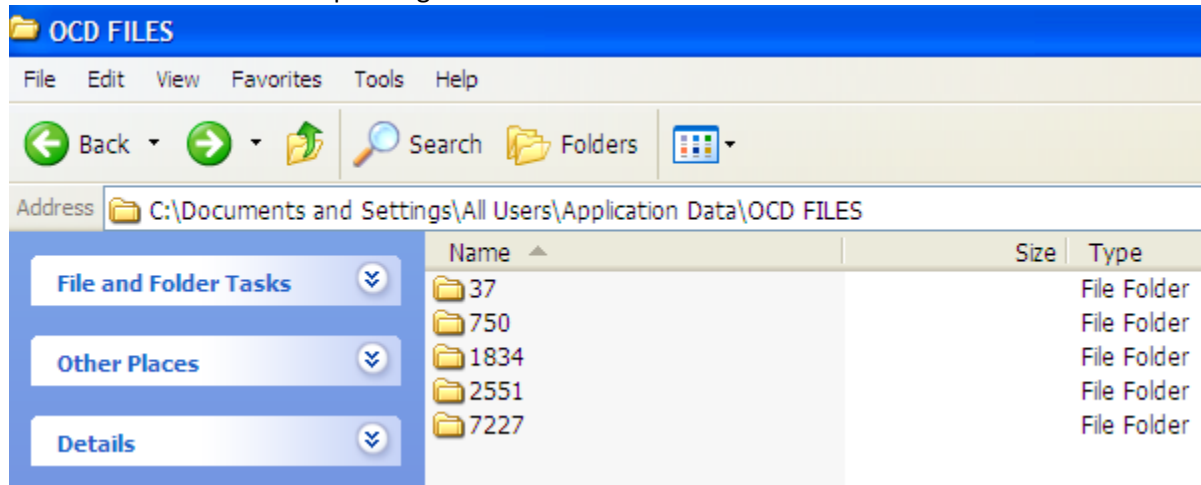
- Click Start button and then Run
- Type C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Application Data Click OK.



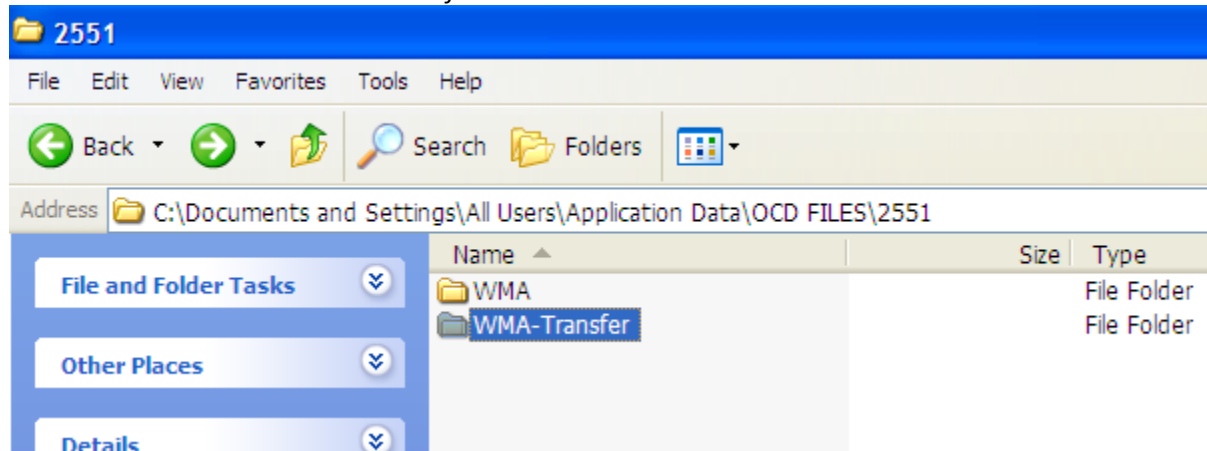
- Double-click OCD Files.

Windows 7/Vista Users

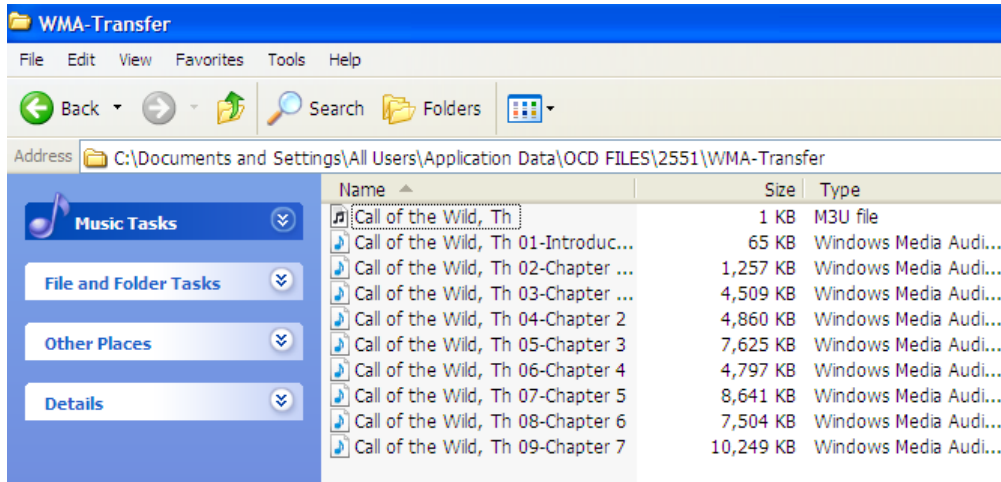
- Open Start menu. In the address bar enter `c:\programdata` and hit enter.
- Double-click *OCD Files*.
- A separate folder will be created for each title you have downloaded, named with a unique number to a corresponding title. Double-click one of these folders.



- Double-click the *WMA-Transfer* folder.

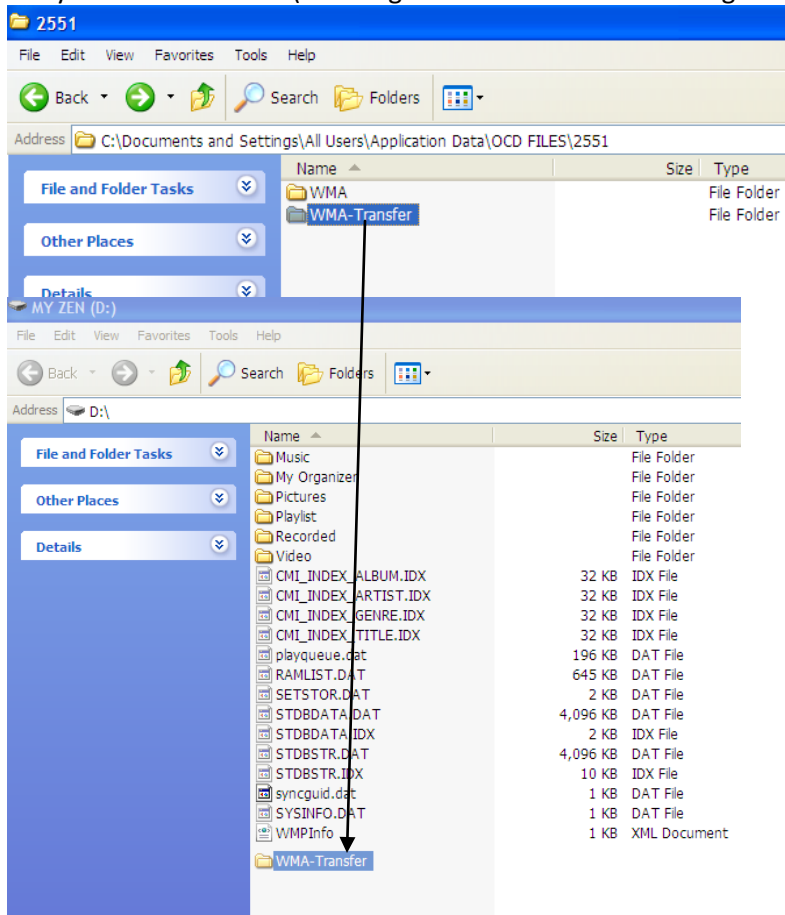


- The title and additional track information will be displayed in the track names. Return to the above screen (folder containing the *WMA-Transfer* subfolder).

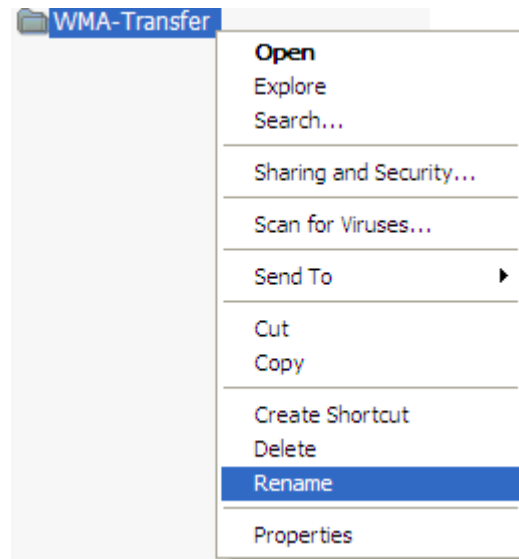


Transfer

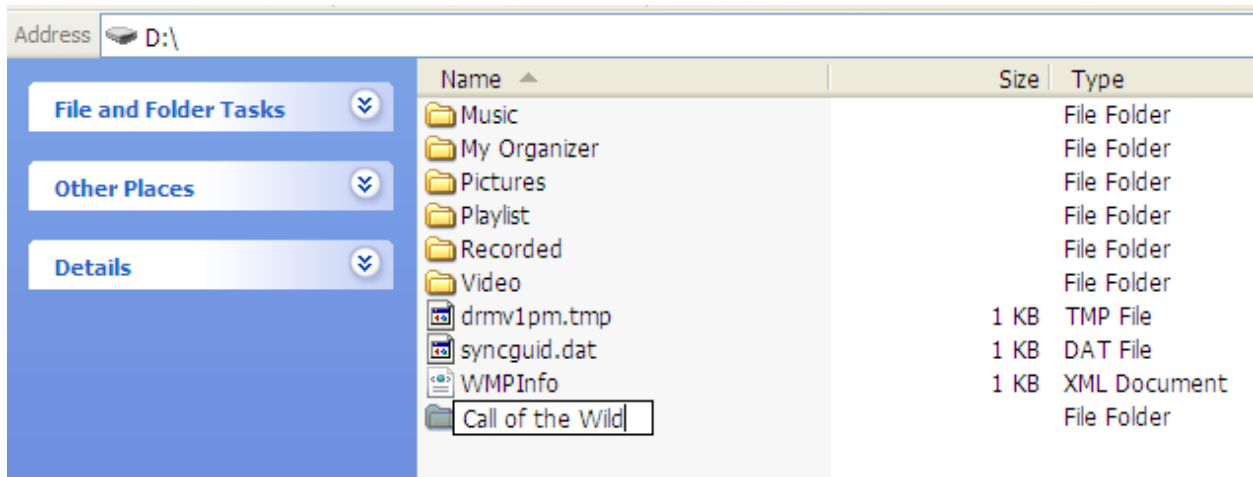
- Left-click the *WMA-Transfer* folder and hold the mouse button down while you drag this into your device folder. (Warning: do not add it to an existing subfolder.)



- Allow all files to transfer. Rename the WMA-Transfer now located in your device folder by right-clicking the folder and left-clicking *Rename*.



- Pressing the Enter key will save this change.



- You can find your title on your device in the Music folder. Disconnect device and enjoy!
